

TMA Documents Revisions

Changes to the Tara Master Association Documents (Declarations and Bylaws) have been proposed and should be coming up for a membership vote some time in 2016. To learn about the revisions, there will be two more informational town hall meetings:

- 1) Dec. 16, 2-4 p.m. at Tara Golf and Country Club,
- 2) Jan. 12, 3-5 p.m. at Preserve Community Center

The most recent meeting was Nov. 12 at the Preserve Community Center. Quoting from the meeting handout:

"Our TMA documents were originally written in 2001 & have only been revised during Developer control. They contain outdated statements that no longer comply with Florida State Law. References to the Developer are no longer relevant, as he has been gone from involvement in the TMA for 10 years.

"Therefore, the Board of Directors appointed a committee, the **Document Review Committee** (composed of equal numbers of Tara and Preserve residents), that has been working on updating & revising our governing documents since May 2013. The Board, TMA attorney, and the TMA's management company ALL recommend their adoption. They are being released for membership review."

Try to attend one of the two remaining informational meetings! Your copy of the proposed documents and limited voting proxy will be mailed to you Dec. $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ by the TMA . Voting is scheduled for January 15.

Tara Boulevard Median Improvements

On Nov. 11, the concept plan for the proposed Tara **Boulevard Median Improvements** was presented by its designer (the landscape architectural firm of Stewart-Washmuth & Co.) at a special Tara Master Association Board meeting. There were questions from the Board members and the audience, but the plan was generally favorably received.

Next step is Board approval, followed by completion of design, bidding, and contract award. Construction is expected to take about a month in mid-winter, 2016.

The Washingtonian palm trees (67) and all of the other existing plants will be taken down, except for the existing crape myrtle trees.

To reduce costs, the **Tara Landscape Committee** is trying to find a party interested in buying and removing the palm trees.


Proposed replacement plantings include:

- Cabbage palm trees (100)
- Muhly grass under the cabbage palms





- Japanese blueberry trees (24)
- Additional crape myrtle trees (25)
- Asiatic jasmine at the noses (ends) of the boulevard sections





Important design considerations include:

- Line-of-sight at all intersections for traffic safety
- Slower-growing palm tree
- Hardiness of plant selections (plants tender to cold temps were avoided)
- Low maintenance plants, to keep costs down
- Plant choice and layout to create a striking view
- Tree choices that will receive County approval

Preserve Golf Course Improvements

The <u>Preserve Golf Club at Tara</u> has been undertaking some needed maintenance improvements this year. Just a few examples:



- Cleaned and painted course restrooms (including those at-the-turn) this summer
- In October, overseeded entire course
- Re-grading (continuing weekly) of the gravel cart paths
- Expanded restaurant menu
- Instituted Happy Hour at 4 p.m. daily

Coming later this year, the at-the-turn food/beverage stop under the clubhouse will reopen. And the restaurant's overall food menu will continue to be expanded, including sandwiches, wraps and other items.

All of these welcome improvements are coming under the direction of new General Manager **David Collumbell**. David's not exactly new – he had been the first General Manager when the course initially opened.

If you haven't golfed here in a while, give it a shot. It's still a great layout, with course and clubhouse conditions and services improving on a daily basis.



Road Construction on 1-75 continues, to convert the University Parkway interchange to the new <u>diverging diamond</u> design. The project is about 12% complete. Sign-up <u>here</u> to receive weekly updates via email.

In the near future:

Nov./Dec.: Delivery and assembly of <u>Acrow Bridge</u> (a temporary I-75 bridge over University Parkway to allow demolition of the existing I-75 bridges)

Dec.: Launch Acrow Bridge over University Parkway **Jan. 2016:** Shift I-75 south-bound traffic onto the Acrow Bridge

Feb. 2016: Demolition of existing south-bound I-75 bridge

Information on *I-75 upgrades between Fruitville Road and University Parkway* is available at the <u>FDOT website</u>. Estimated completion: Summer, 2017.

Information on *I-75 upgrades from University*Parkway to SR 64 (including reconstruction of the I-75/SR 70 interchange) is also available, on this page of the FDOT website. Design is underway, scheduled for completion in the spring of 2016.

Construction is as-yet unfunded.



